







Background



- In 2014, the Legislature passed groundwater legislation collectively known as the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA)

Agency Coordination




- Local agencies are working together to develop a Sutter Subbasin Groundwater Sustainability Plan, due to be submitted to the State by January 31, 2022

Participating Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs)





Analysis



- This plan will have a role in determining groundwater management in the region overlying the Sutter Subbasin
- The City of Yuba City will benefit by participating, as the City relies on groundwater to meet drinking water demands in drought years

Fiscal Impact




- The City share for plan development is not to exceed \$4,505

Alternatives




- The City could decline to participate in the process. If so, the City would lose the ability to provide input as a stakeholder in the Sutter Subbasin groundwater management process.
