National Animal Shelter Appreciation Week

November 6-12, 2022

WHEREAS, there are more than 45 million cats and 69 million dogs living in more than 90 million households across the United States; and

WHEREAS, the irresponsibility of some pet owners and resulted in animals running loose and unsupervised, causing a threat to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, pet owners who have not had their companion animals spayed or neutered contribute to pet overpopulation; and

WHEREAS, animal shelters help both animals and people in many ways: by returning lost pets to their owners, enforcing animal control laws, rescuing injured animals, educating the public, and matching up families with new animal companions; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that I, Dave Shaw, Mayor of the City of Yuba City and on behalf of the entire City Council, do hereby proclaim the week of November 6 - 12, 2022 to be National Animal Shelter Appreciation Week in recognition of Sutter Animal Services Authority for providing compassionate services to animals and people in our community.
