


- The reconstruction of Plumas St.

- The potential redevelopment of the former Feather Rivers Mills site


3-Prong Approach


| CCSP Plan Update |  |

| Phase 1          | Amend Feather River Mills property given that the property no longer serves as an industrial site  |
| Phase 2          | Update regulations pertaining to restaurants that serve alcohol, bars, and nightclubs  |
| Phase 3          | Recalibrate existing zoning regulations, including identifying those<br>uses the City would like to promote, while also identifying uses that<br>have the potential to detract from the City center. Potential benefits<br>include reducing entitlement processing times for applicants while<br>also helping encourage growth to desired areas. |


#### Phase 1 - Feather Ríver Mills













- Environmental Assessment
- Amendments to:
  - Central City Specific Plan
  - General Plan
- The site is currently zoned C-2 (Community Commercial), thus no changes are required.



- Existing zoning permits a hotel, however the Specific Plan and General Plan designate the site for industrial uses
  - Light Industrial
  - Storefront Commercial

Traffic Impact Study

- City commissioned a Traffic Impact Study
- Traffic Impact Study
  - 7 intersections assessed
  - Some impact to the intersection of Boyd and B St.
  - Applicant will be required to pay their fair-share

### Remedial Action Plan

- The City commissioned the study because of known contamination
  - The Action Plan identifies contaminates & remediation actions
  - 35 exploratory trenches, 7 soil borings to groundwater
  - 3 groundwater monitoring wells
  - None of the contaminates migrated to the underlying groundwater

### Remedial Action Plan

- Approximately 10,500 cubic yards of material will excavated from the 6.56 acres
- The remediation will allow for unrestricted land uses after completion
- Action Plan was approved by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board
- Costs to remediate: \$1.5 million



- An environmental assessment including an initial study and mitigated negative declaration was prepared and circulation to state and Tribal consultation
- Mitigation is incorporated into the conditions of approval to decrease impacts to less than significant

### Recommendation

- Adopt the environmental assessment including an initial study and Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring Plan
- Approve the General Plan Amendment
- Approve the Specific Plan Amendment
