Role of the Commission

- Delegated authority by the City Council
- Primary entity through which land use entitlements are considered
- Operate through adopted bylaws



Role of the Commission

- Acts as an advisory board to the City Council on all development issues
- Permanent committee comprised of 7 individuals
- Appointed by the Mayor and Council



Role of the Commission

- Assures that the General Plan is implemented by reviewing development projects on a case-by-case basis
- Functions as the decision-making body for projects
- Recommendations to the City Council

Individual Project Review

- Since Jan. 2017:
 - 16 meetings
 - 20 projects
 - 2 workshops
 - 1 zoning code text amendment
 - 1 initiated text amendment
